Maizey Plastics and Exion Corporation believe they will deliver a better, market leading product to the signage industry.







QuestionS To Ask

WHEN VISITING A SIGNAGE AND PRINTING EXPO



Expo's are an ideal opportunity to interact with industry experts about equipment and products you're investing in, or services you're considering adding to your business. Some of our exhibitors give a useful tool kit of questions visitors to the Africa Print Expo — and any expo in general — should ask when investing in digital label printing, photo book printing and digital printing.

Digital Label Printing

Leon Minnie, Konica Minolta South Africa, stand G01, Hall 2

Label printing has mainly been handled by conventional processes such as flexography, however, with run lengths becoming shorter and the demand for customisation, digital label printing is an attractive option that can complement conventional printing. Benefits of digital printing include getting jobs done faster, improving profitability, efficiency and productivity while decreasing material wastage and reducing set-up time for machinery.

Will you have the facilities to set up a label printing division?

You'll need a dedicated space for media and printing, which should be easily accessible for media and equipment to be delivered and installed. A dedicated digital finisher that fulfills the requirements would also be beneficial.

What are the minimum quantities of substrates required by the supplier to be purchased?

If you want to try out a specialised material, for instance, you need to take into account the lifespan of the media.

Will the volume justify a return on investment?

This is an important consideration, however, one must also take into account the flexibility gained from digital printing. Being able to use labels in a marketing capacity, where companies can do versioning of different brands, or short and specific marketing campaigns with variable data printing, like the famous Coca-Cola example of personalised cans, is a major benefit. Providing premium products that are tailored to specific market segments can offset the volume

What about finishing?

Finishing, specifically the expenses associated with die cutting, rewinding labels, lamination, UV coating, spot UV and spot foiling, needs to be considered. This type of finishing could come at a considerable cost and requires an experienced operator.

Does the supplier offer comprehensive cost analysis?

Businesses need a comprehensive cost analysis to ensure whether bringing label-printing in-house will be profitable. Konica Minolta South Africa does a cost analysis using business tools to verify cost per label, percentage of the machine used, monthly production capacity and benchmarking against other label print processes like flexo, among other aspects, to ascertain if digital printing is the right fit for your business.

Does the supplier offer training?

Although digital printers are easier to run than flexo, you still need

qualified staff who know how to plan print, manipulate colours, and handle any post-finishing. We offer two training sessions, one basic, and one advanced, to our clients.

Photo Books

How many books do you produce monthly?

If you are starting out then the volume of books is going to be low. Our new system is ideal for small volumes below 500 per month.

How thick is your standard book?

This will give you an indication of the consumables you will need, the cover sizes that you want in stock and the other sizes you can order on demand to help you start out. It will also give you a page capacity you can pass on to your customers.

What kind of finish would you like?

With the industry growing, the finishing results are becoming endless. Try limit your options to customers until you build a strong customer base. Stick to the standard finish covers and as your demand comes in you can always expand your machinery and offering. You can include foiling, embossing, vinyl stickers and laminated finishing to name a few

How much are you willing to spend on a photo book machine, to get started?

Your budget will work hand in hand with your demand. If you have 1000 plus customers then you can look at industrial machines but until then, you don't want to overspend. Work out the capital outlay and how long it will take to make your money back.

What type of work do you want to do?

You wouldn't use a unit that can do photo quality on coated stock to print training manuals and no carbon required (NCR) materials.

What are the expected monthly volumes?

A toner based printer may have a claimed spec of 500,000 a month, but will it cope if most of that work comes in one week? Toner based printers have heated fusers that are seldom designed to run continuously for 10-12 hour shifts.

What are the expected production speeds?

Usually the faster the toner based machine is, the higher the print volume rating and the cost.

What is the expected life of the printer in prints?

Relate this to the finance or write-off period, say three years. It's no good having a 5 million print lifespan if you are expecting to do this volume in two years. Inkjet's cold process and minimal moving parts will give a longer life relative to capital outlay than toner based machines (up to 18 million prints).

What is the cost per print?

Beware of a fixed click charge including toner, especially when printing low ink/toner coverage documents such as training manuals and forms. We offer a maintenance only charge and you purchase only the ink you require. With this facility comes an online ink coverage and cost measuring tool that allows competitive quoting without fear of under/overcharging.

How does the printer handle variable data?

Numbering NCR is a variable data function — you need equipment that can handle this.




